

**EVALUATION COMMITTEE MINUTES – No. 1****PUBLIC NOTICE FOR THE SELECTION OF 9 EXPERTS IN SUPPORT OF CO-DESIGN PROCESSES WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE PROJECT “EMPOWERING NEW ENERGIES AND RESOURCES IN GREECE ITALY AREA” (ACRONYM ENERGIE), FINANCED BY THE INTERREG GREECE–ITALY PROGRAMME 2021/2027**

On 30 April 2026, at 10:02 a.m., the Evaluation Committee (hereinafter also referred to as the “Committee”) convened online via the Google Meet platform to carry out the assessment of the applications received in response to the above-referenced Public Notice for the selection of no. 9 (nine) professional resources to support the activities of the ENERGIE project.

As a preliminary matter, having been informed of the names of the applicants, the members of the Committee hereby declare, by signing these Minutes, the absence of any grounds for conflict of interest, incompatibility, or ineligibility for appointment, pursuant to applicable legislation.

The Committee proceeds by reviewing the above-referenced Public Notice, taking note that the identification of the nine (9) professional resources to be appointed shall be carried out through a selection procedure based on comparative CV assessment and individual interview, in accordance with the provisions of the Regulation governing the assignment of individual appointments of the Regional Agency for Technology, Technology Transfer and Innovation (ARTI).

The Committee records that a maximum of ten (10) candidates per profile, as set out in Article 2 of the Public Notice, shall be admitted to the interview, based on separate ranking lists drawn up for each profile, reflecting the scores obtained in the CV assessment phase. In the event of a tie in the scores awarded for the last eligible position in any ranking list, all tied candidates shall be admitted to the interview.

The Committee recalls that the Public Notice has established the following general eligibility requirements, namely that applicants must:

- a) be no older than 35 years of age on the closing date for submission of applications;



- b) be citizens of a Member State of the European Union or of a third country (non-EU);
- c) not to have received criminal convictions, including non-final judgments, for offences regulated under Book II, Title II, Chapter I of the Italian Criminal Code, nor to be subject to preventive measures, civil rulings, or administrative sanctions recorded in the criminal record;
- d) not to be subject to any ongoing criminal proceedings;
- e) not to have been dismissed, discharged or otherwise removed from employment in a Public Administration due to persistent insufficient performance, nor declared unfit for public employment due to submission of false or invalid documentation;
- f) not to have been convicted of the crimes referred to in Articles 600-bis, 600-ter, 600-quater, 600-quinquies, 609-undecies of the Italian Criminal Code, nor to have received prohibitory sanctions related to activities involving direct and regular contact with minors.

The Committee likewise recalls that the Public Notice has established the following specific professional requirements:

- a) possession of a university degree (Bachelor's Degree) of at least European Qualifications Framework level 6 (EQF 6), relevant to one of the profiles listed in Article 2 of the Public Notice and for which the application is submitted;
- b) at least two (2) years of professional experience in activities consistent with one of the profiles listed in Article 2 of the Public Notice and for which the application is submitted, including experience gained in European or international projects, territorial innovation contexts and/or co-design processes, urban regeneration, post-industrial reconversion, local development, or environmental and energy transition initiatives.

The Committee further acknowledges that:

- pursuant to Article 4 of the Public Notice, applications for participation in the selection procedure were submitted electronically through the dedicated web page of the Public Notice (<https://www.arti.puglia.it/amm-trasparente/9-experts-energie>), available on the ARTI website in the "Amministrazione Trasparente" (Transparent Administration) section, under the subsection "Bandi di Concorso – Avvisi" (Calls for Applications – Notices);
- upon submission of each application, the information system automatically assigned each applicant a unique eight-character alphanumeric reference code, which was simultaneously transmitted to the applicant by way of a submission confirmation notice. This code constitutes the unique identifier of the application throughout the entire duration of the procedure, in accordance with the principle of anonymity and the applicable personal data protection legislation (EU Regulation 2016/679).

The Committee further takes note that, pursuant to Article 4 of the Public Notice, the Application Form, drafted in English in accordance with the template set out in Annex 1, must be accompanied by the following mandatory attachments:

1. a copy of a valid identification document;



2. a Curriculum Vitae et Studiorum, drafted in English, dated and signed by the applicant, including the declarations pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 445/2000 and the authorisations for the processing of personal data pursuant to EU Regulation 2016/679.

The Committee, having verified the compliance and having identified deficiencies, omissions, and irregularities in the Application Forms and in the supporting documentation submitted, draws up the corresponding list — set out in Annex 1 to these Minutes, of which it forms an integral part — for the purposes of initiating the suppletive documentation procedure (*“soccorso istruttorio”*), pursuant to applicable legislation. The said list shall be transmitted to the Person Responsible for the Procedure (RUP), who shall adopt the measures falling within their competence for the dispatch of the relevant requests for integration and/or regularisation.

Having concluded the proceeding, the Committee instructs the Recording Secretary to draft these Minutes and the relevant Annex 1, which shall subsequently be submitted to the members of the Committee for formal approval and signature.
